Unique Student Identifier

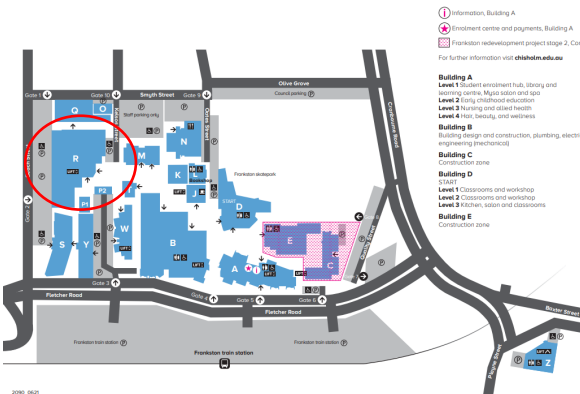
If not already held, participants must apply for a Unique Student Identification number (USI). This is a government requirement for all students, and it is not possible to enroll unless the number has been provided.
